



Minutes of the Dispute Resolution Commission
Convened Under the Ohio Director of Health Stay-at-Home Order
April 9, 2020 – 4:45 p.m.

Chairman Randazzo called the second meeting of the Dispute Resolution Commission to order.

Chairman Randazzo called the roll. All three Commissioners confirmed their participation.

Chairman Randazzo thanked local and state health authorities for their efforts to manage the virus, and briefly reiterated the Commission's role.

Commissioner Maxfield moved to approve the minutes from April 8, 2020. Commissioner Mihalik seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Chairman Randazzo announced that there were five requests before the Commission, but only three would be decided during the current meeting. Regarding one of the deferred requests, Chairman Randazzo explained that the Commission needed additional time to review information regarding the beauty supply stores at issue.

The Commission addressed the next three requests concurrently. All involved car-wash businesses. Chairman Randazzo explained that the businesses have terminated employee interactions with customers, terminated vacuum services, and that some businesses provide service to first responders. Chairman Randazzo explained the Commission's decision—that the Commission agrees with local determinations that these businesses perform essential functions.
