

**Minutes of the Dispute Resolution Commission  
Convened Under the Ohio Director of Health Stay-at-Home Order  
April 21, 2020 – 4:00 p.m.**

Chairman Randazzo called the fourth meeting of the Dispute Resolution Commission to order.

Chairman Randazzo called the roll. All three Commissioners confirmed their participation.

Commissioner Maxfield moved to approve the minutes from April 16, 2020. Commissioner Mihalik seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Chairman Randazzo announced that there was one request before the Commission, brought by local health authorities and a business. He announced the opinion determines the business to be essential. Similar to requests determined at the last meeting, the Chairman explained the business sells dry goods, pet supplies, nonalcoholic beverages, masks, gloves, disinfecting wipes, toilet paper, toothpaste, deodorant, medical items, cleaning supplies, bottled water, and other personal hygiene products. He stated that the business may stay open to sell these essential products only if the sale of nonessential products is incidental to the sale of the essential products. The business's essential status will be lost if the sale of nonessential goods becomes more than incidental.
