Columbiana County COVID Vaccination Taskforce Releases PSAs Highlighting the Importance of Vaccination

Locally produced PSAs encourage Columbiana County residents to get the shot.

COLUMBUS – The Columbiana County COVID Vaccination Taskforce has produced a [30-second commercial](#) and a [2-minute PSA](#) highlighting the importance and benefits of getting vaccinated against COVID-19.

After noticing a slowdown in vaccination rates in the county, the taskforce developed a vaccine hesitancy survey that was sent to local community partners. One of the points generated from that survey was the need for more local education on the importance of vaccination.

The PSAs were created using COVID-19 grant funding and feature local medical professionals that members of the community know and trust. Taskforce members volunteered to develop a message with the theme *vaccines are safe, vaccines are effective, and vaccines are available... don't hesitate, vaccinate!*

The Columbiana County COVID Vaccination Task force includes representatives from three health departments in the county, two local hospitals, the Federally Qualified Health Center at Community Action Agency of Columbiana County, the Area Agency on Aging, and local pharmacies.

The taskforce wants members of the community to know that there is ample supply of all three COVID-19 vaccines available in in the county. The Columbiana County Health District continues various outreach methods, including a planned on-site vaccination clinic at the Columbiana County Fair next week.
