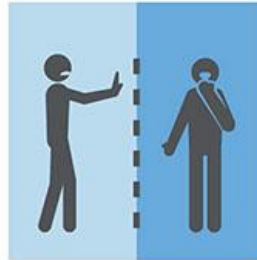

OR LONGER)



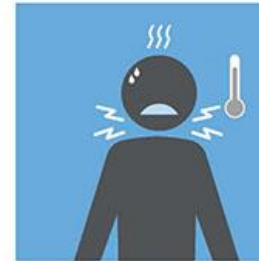
AVOID TOUCHING
