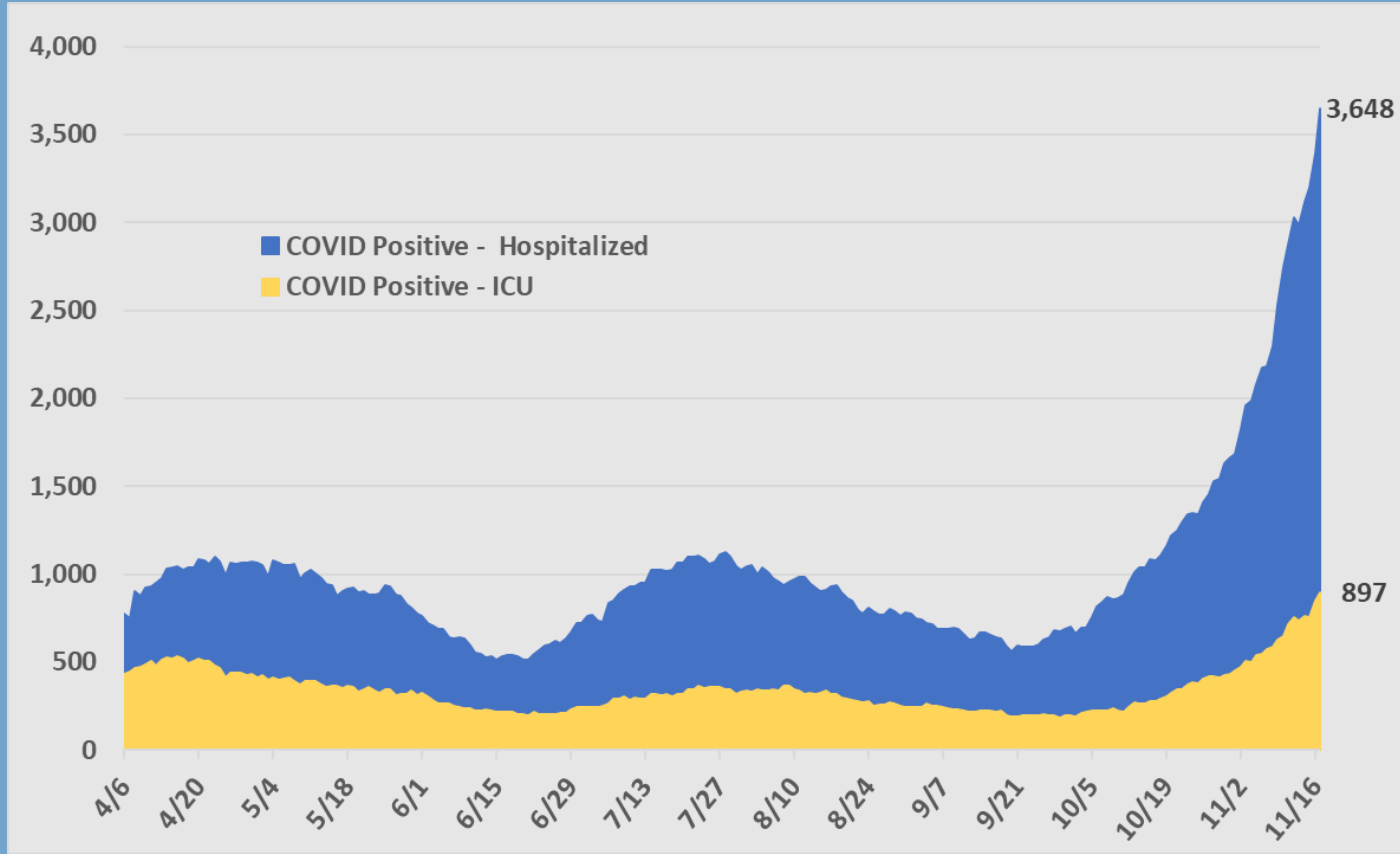

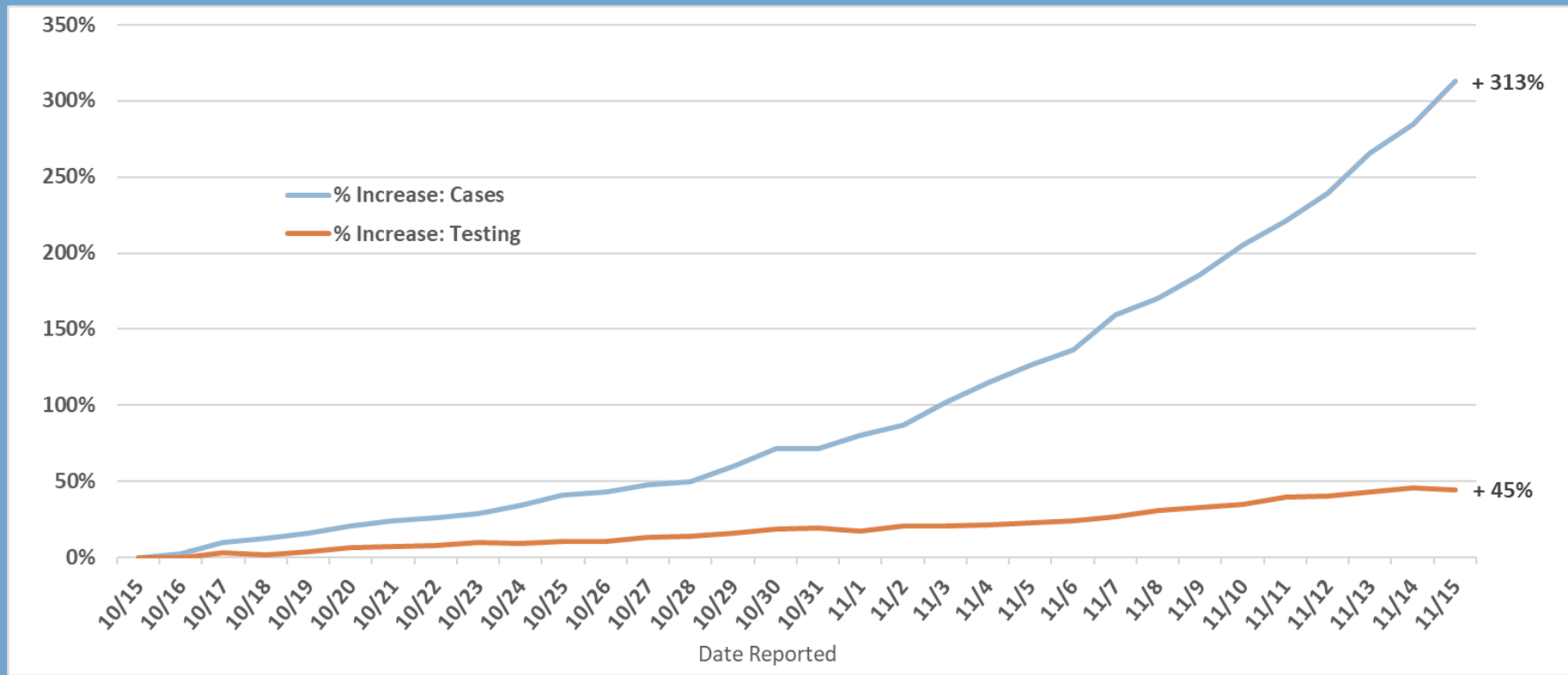

# COVID-19 | Cases vs. Testing: Percent Increases in Past Month



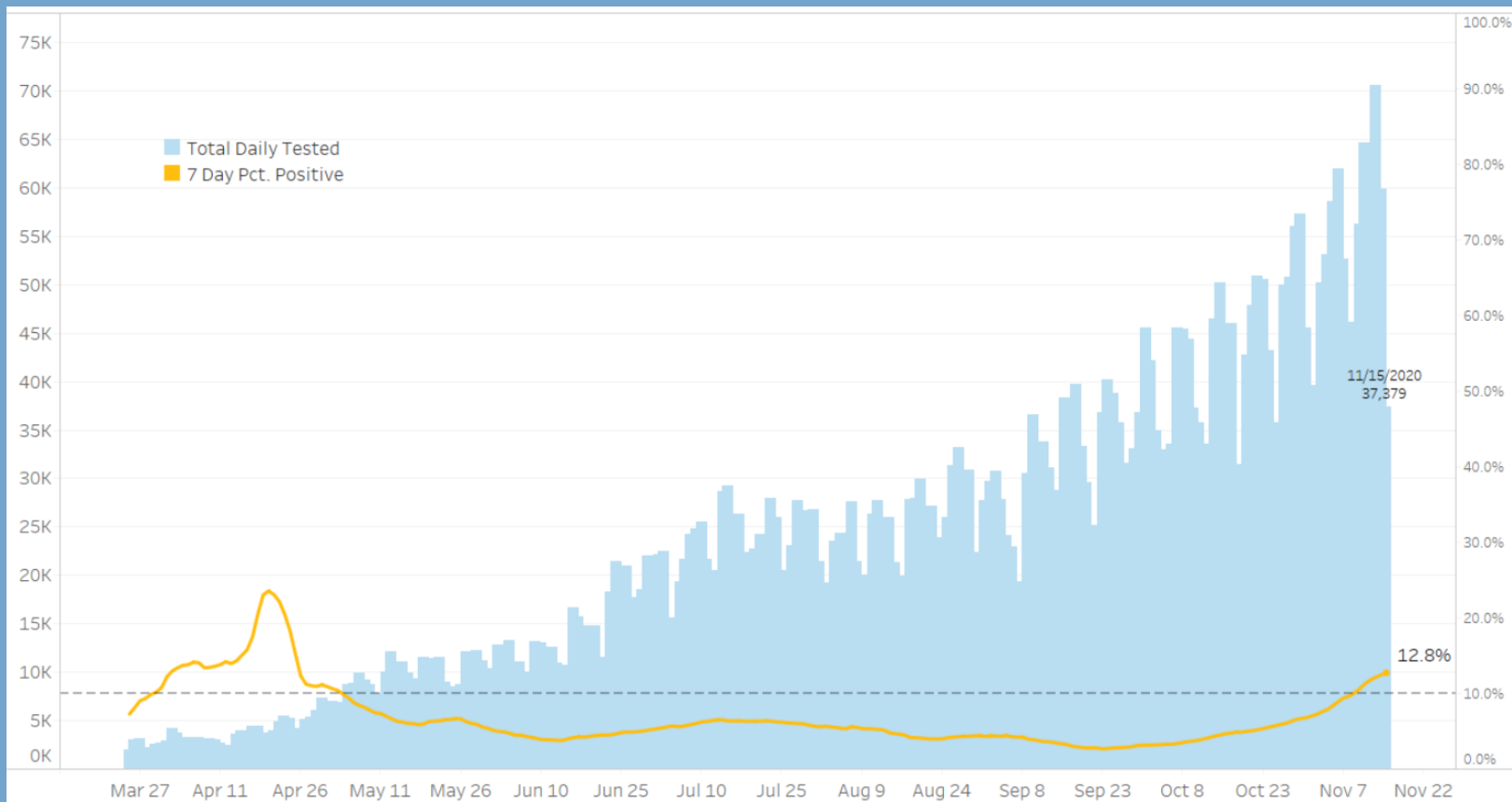
