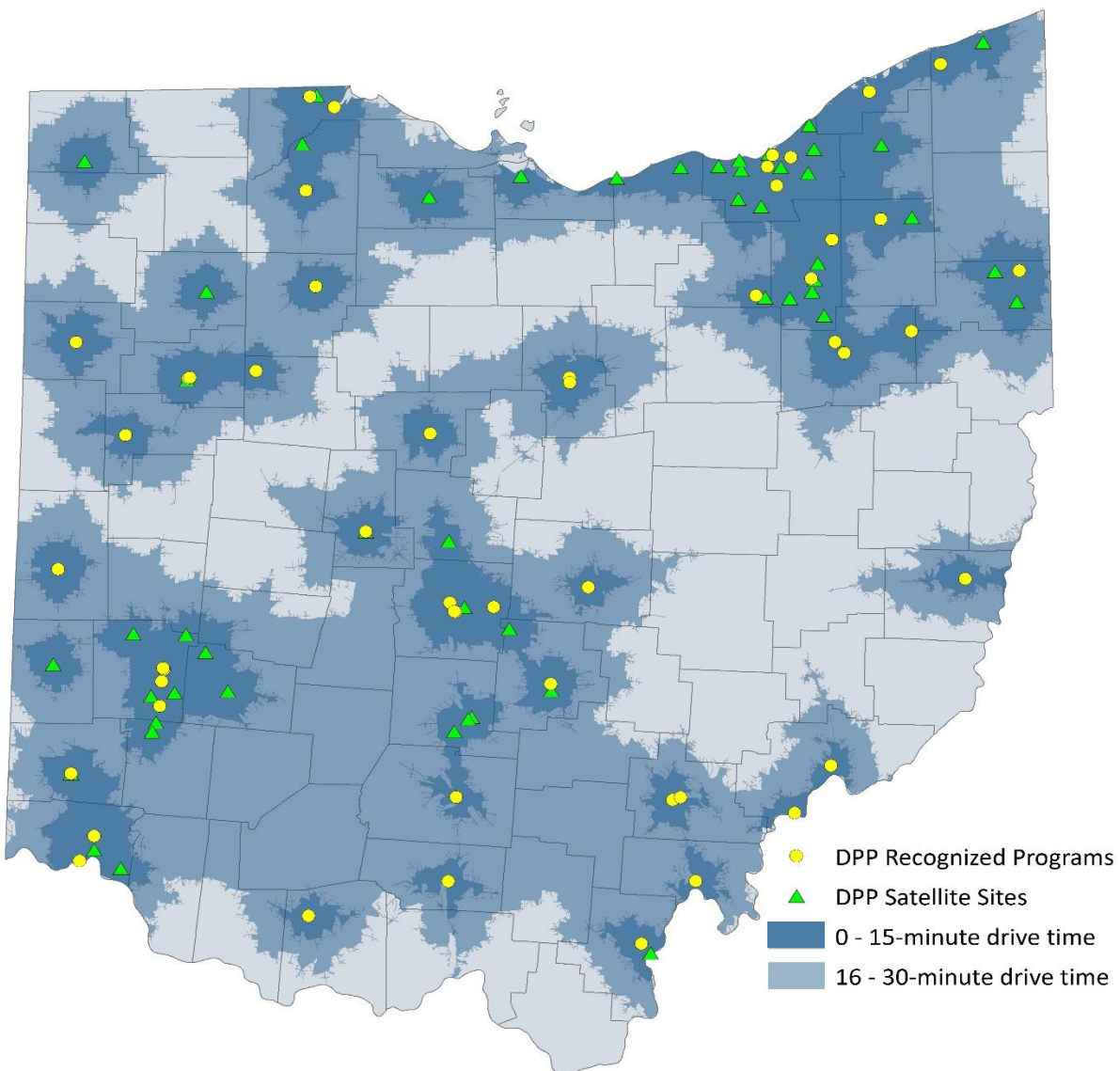


**Population coverage within 15- and 30-minute drive times of an Ohio, CDC-recognized National Diabetes Prevention Program (N-DPP) Lifestyle Change Program, Ohio, 2018**



Utilizing the population-weighted centroid of census block groups and the locations of the 13 CDC-recognized N-DPPs in Ohio, this geospatial analysis shows that only 27.3 percent of Ohioans live within a 15-minute drive of an Ohio N-DPP location. An additional 29.9 percent live within a 30-minute drive. Thus, only 57.2 percent of Ohioans live within 30 minutes of an Ohio, CDC-recognized N-DPP provider, leaving nearly five million Ohioans without ready access to these services. In addition, the majority of counties with the highest diabetes death rates do not currently have a N-DPP located within the county.
