

### **Additional Q & A's (after the Bidders Conference)**

Does "To provide direct service of Sexual Risk Avoidance to youth, with 60% of those served in the target counties" mean that if you have 10,000 youth in the target population that 6,000 are served? Or does it mean that 40% of the youth served can be in counties that were not identified as target counties? **That means that if you serve 10,000 in your WHOLE region, 6,000 of them (at least) must come from the target counties identified in your region.**

Are the 4 performance goals (pg 6) to be completed for each of the 3 preceding goals? **No, the Goals are the overall goals of the program; the performance goals are more specific descriptions of what activities are expected to achieve those goals.** Basically, are we completing 4 performance goals or 12 performance goals? **It's four goals**

Can you tell us how the performance goals (pg 6) correlate to the process objectives and/or outcome objectives listed in the Methodology section (pg 17)? **Process objectives and outcome objectives should be developed by the applicant for each performance goal.**

If the performance goals are not the process or outcome objectives, can you tell us where those can be found in the RFP or are these objectives that we develop for the region? Secondly, are we writing outcome objectives for each performance goal? **Process objectives and outcome objectives should be developed by the applicant for each performance goal.**

The methodology section has a sentence that states "Each outcome objective should have at least one process and outcome objective and activities describing how the objective will be accomplished". Do you have an example of where an outcome objective has an outcome objective or is it a typo that it was included in the sentence? **It's a typo. The sentence should read: Each outcome objective should have at least one process objective and activities describing how the outcome objective will be accomplished"**

May we include tables in our program narrative, and if so, must they adhere to the 1.5 line spacing and 12 pt font size requirement of the rest of the document? **Yes, you may include tables, but there is no need to stick to the font and spacing requirements for them**

Should we go ahead and submit the budget narrative even though we have not heard about the federal funding announcement yet, so our budget will probably change? **Yes submit the budget narrative based on the number given in the NOA as it stands now.**

Do you have any idea when the federal announcement will post? **The last we heard it was, "in the next few weeks"**
