### UNHS reporting transition 2016

All Birthing hospitals have fully transitioned to electronic reporting. Hearing screening results and outcomes are reported directly in IPHIS, i.e. no forms sent to ODH for babies reported in IPHIS.

UNHS forms are completed and sent to ODH for special cases listed below within 10 day timeline:

1. Home births admitted and screened,
2. Re-admits
3. Out of state births
4. Transfers in or out
5. Alternate caregiver (not birth mother, examples adoptions, foster, surrogate, children's services)
6. Objection forms are required to be completed and sent to ODH within 10 days

Note: All results, test type and applicable risk factors are required to be reported to the PCP/medical home and the parent(s)

- 48 hour notification to the medical home is required for non pass babies or missed babies

\* \*Children's Hospitals will have a separate training and reporting process

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
