	Field Note:	In late 2014, ODH Bureau of Vital Statistics added a question to the birth certificate about exclusive breastfeeding at discharge. In 2015 the percent of women who were breastfeeding exclusively at discharge was 52.7%. The percent was higher among white, non-Hispanic women (56.5) when compared to black, non-Hispanic and Hispanic women (37.1 and 48.6 respectively). We expect these percentages to increase as more hospitals implement the Ten Steps to Successful Breastfeeding.
