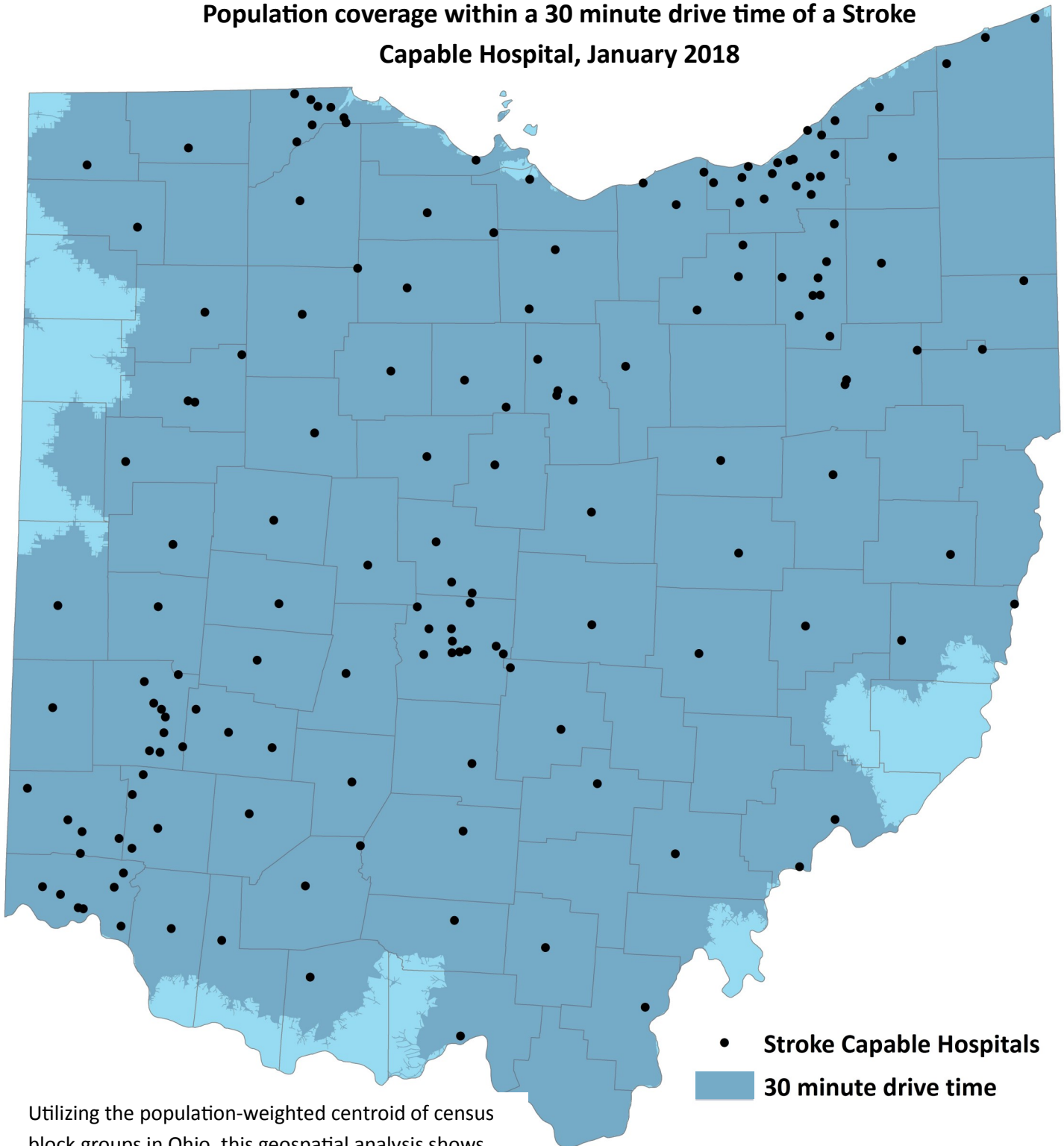


Population coverage within a 30 minute drive time of a Stroke Capable Hospital, January 2018



Utilizing the population-weighted centroid of census block groups in Ohio, this geospatial analysis shows that 98.8 percent of Ohioans live within a 30 minute drive time of a hospital capable of delivering acute stroke care. A stroke capable hospital is defined as a certified acute stroke ready, primary or comprehensive stroke center, or a telestroke hospital.
