Notification of results:

Second Screening: complete for both ears if there was a non-pass on the first screening. Report both sets of results for each ear on the form (if applicable) and IPHIS.

Confirm results and test type:

Screeners and IPHIS staff should verify that results are correct and match the equipment, medical record, form (if applicable) and IPHIS.

Parent Notification:

Culturally sensitive written notification of results for each ear, test type and applicable risk factors is provided to each parent.

Primary Care Provider or Medical Home:

Notification of test results, test type and applicable risk factors is required for all newborns. 48 hour notification is required for babies who did not pass or did not receive the screening/missed babies.

- Quality checks are important to assure screening results are accurate.
- Parents receive written notification of results.
- PCP/Medical home receives notification on all babies. Prompt 48 hour notification for non pass and missed babies

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
