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Background

The 2014 Annual Abortion Report presents information derived from both the “Confidential Abortion Reports” and “Post-Abortion Care Reports for Complications” in Ohio (reporting forms are included as Appendices I and II). Readers should note that abortion statistics in this report are limited to terminations occurring in Ohio; they do not include Ohio residents who obtained abortions outside the state.

Characteristics of Induced Abortions Reported in Ohio, 2014

Induced abortion statistics have been prepared in Ohio since 1976. Many trend comparisons in the 2014 Annual Abortion Report date back to 2001. A total of 21,186 induced pregnancy terminations were reported in Ohio for 2014, including 20,018 obtained by Ohio resident women (94.5 percent). This represents an 8.7 percent reduction in induced pregnancy terminations from 2013 to 2014. Overall, since 2001 there has been a steady decline in terminations. When examined from 2001 to 2014, the annual decline averaged approximately 1,000 per year (Figure 1, page 2).

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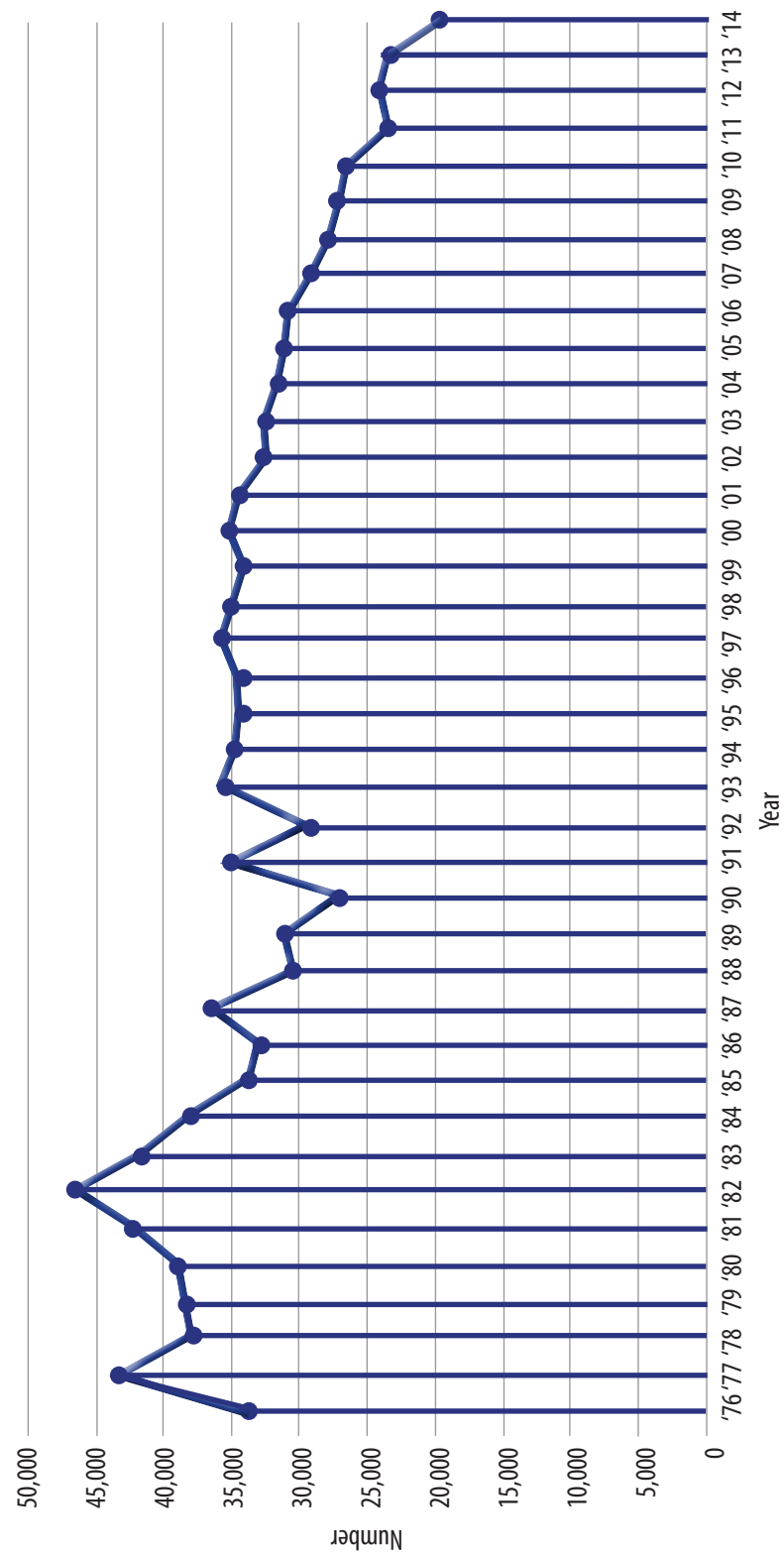
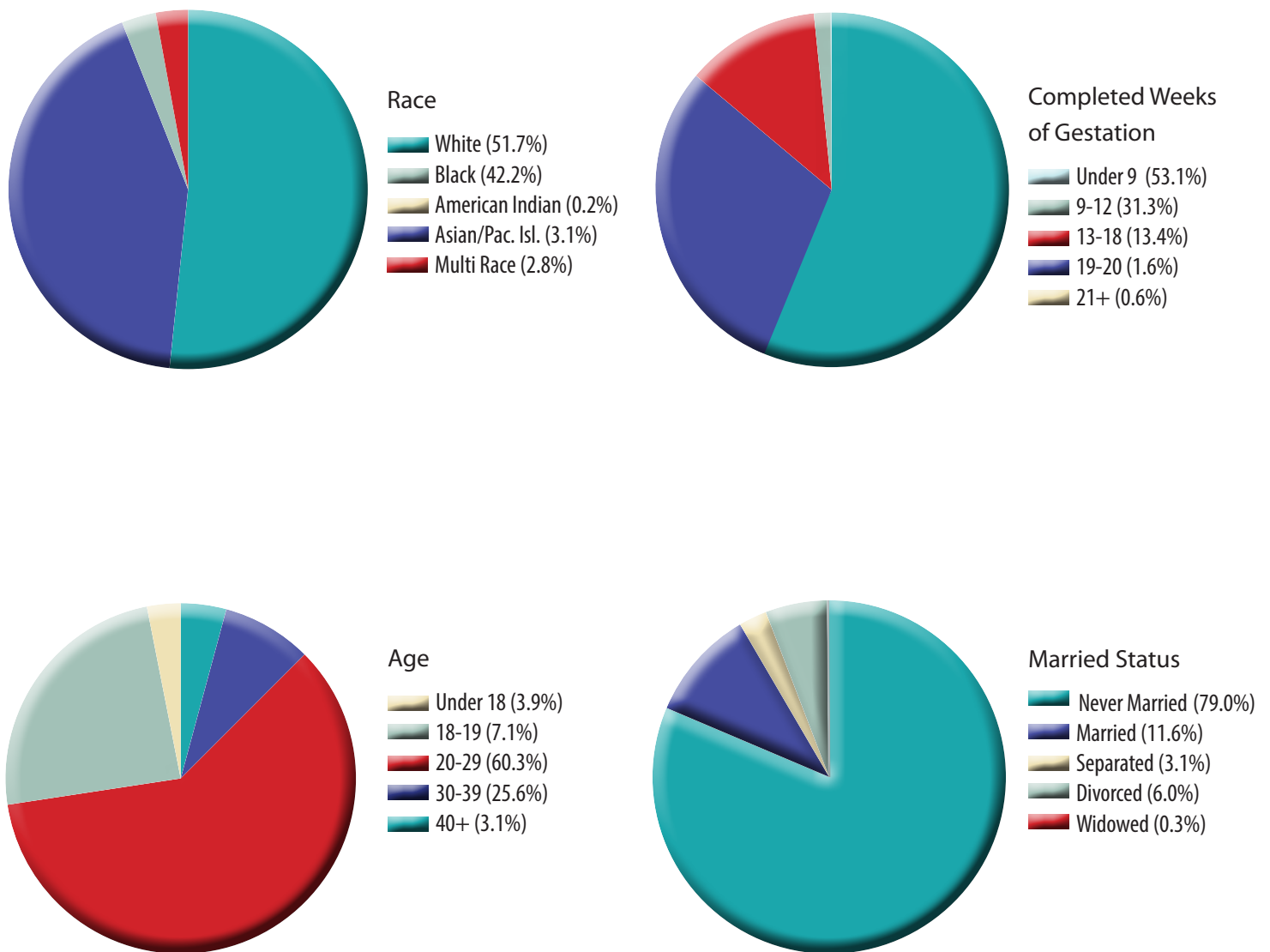


Figure 2. Selected Characteristics of Resident Induced Abortions in Ohio, 2014

Approximately one in nine women who obtained abortions in 2014 were under 20 years of age, with another third between 20 to 24 years of age (Table 2, page 10). While the age distribution of women obtaining abortions has remained relatively unchanged since 2001, the age-specific abortion rates for women under age 25 have steadily decreased (Figure 5, page 6). Approximately 74 percent of women who obtained an abortion were never married, divorced, or widowed (Table 2, page 10). Thirteen percent of procedures were obtained by married or separated women (Table 2, page 10). Fifty-one percent of women who obtained abortions and for whom race was reported were White, 39 percent

were African American, 3 percent were Asian/Pacific Islander (Table 2, page 10), and 3 percent reported more than one race (Figure 2, page 3). Four percent of abortions were obtained by women of Hispanic origin (Table 1, page 9).

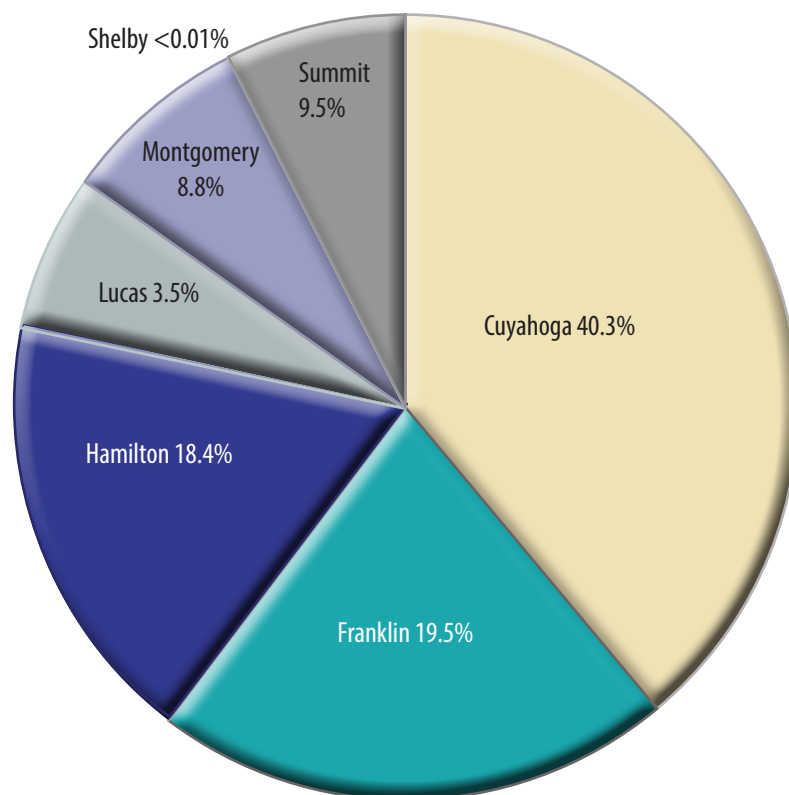
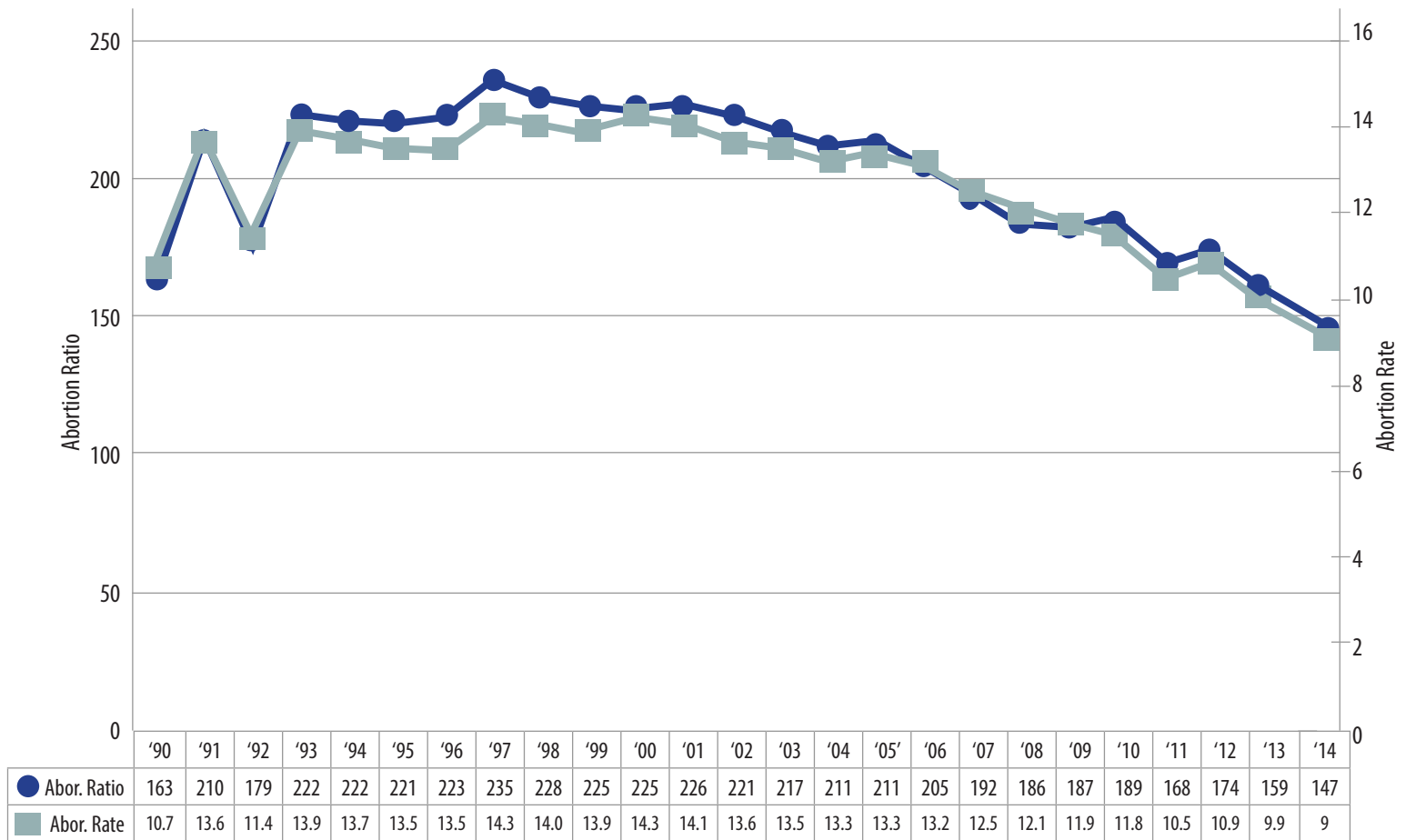


Figure 4. Abortion Ratio and Abortion Rate, by Year, Ohio Residents, 1990 - 2014

The 2014 Ohio abortion rate was 9.0 per 1,000 resident women ages 15 to 44 years old, down from 9.9 in 2013 (Figure 4, page 5). The 2014 Ohio resident abortion ratio was 147 abortions per 1,000 live births, down from 159 in 2013 (Figure 4, page 5).

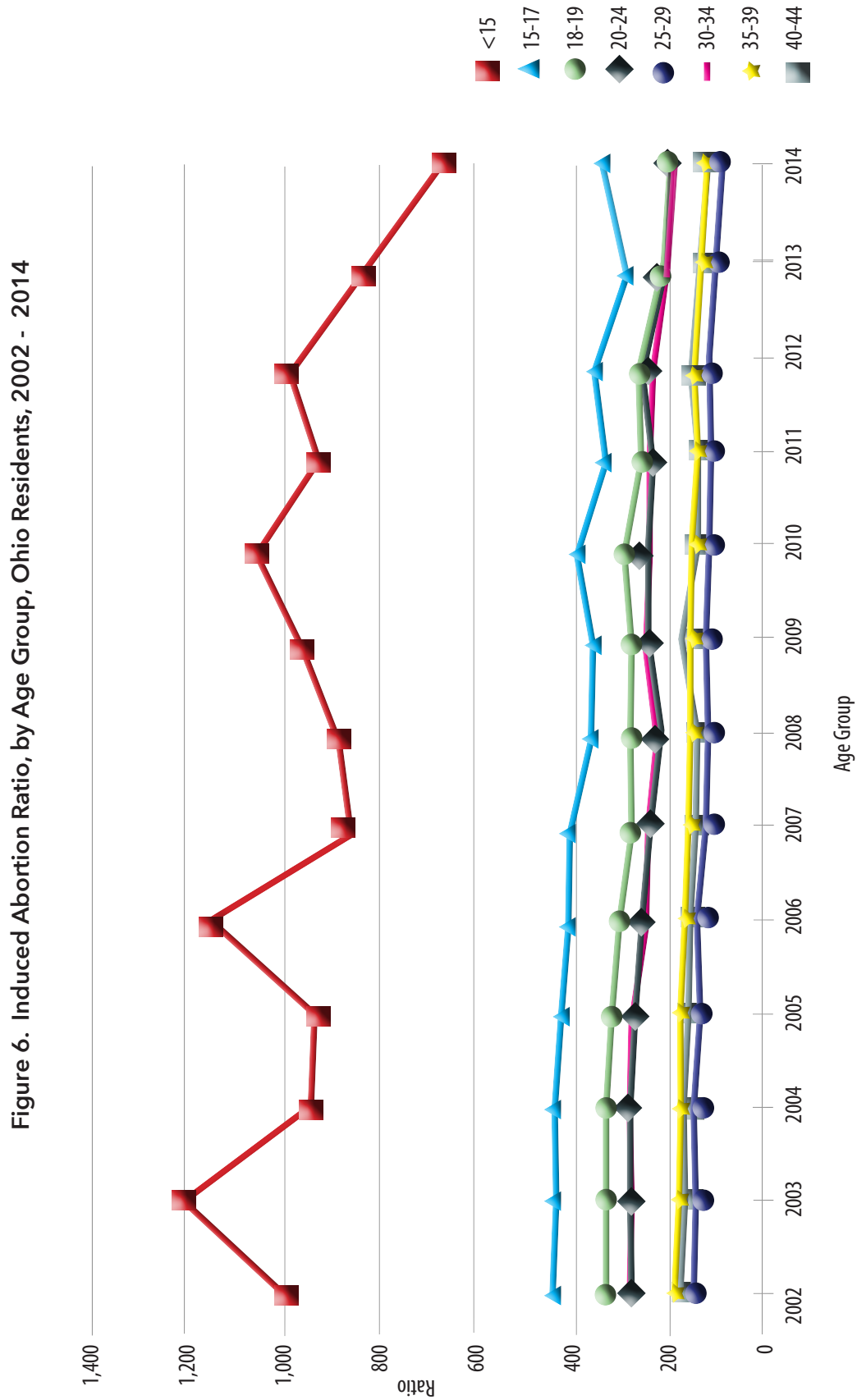
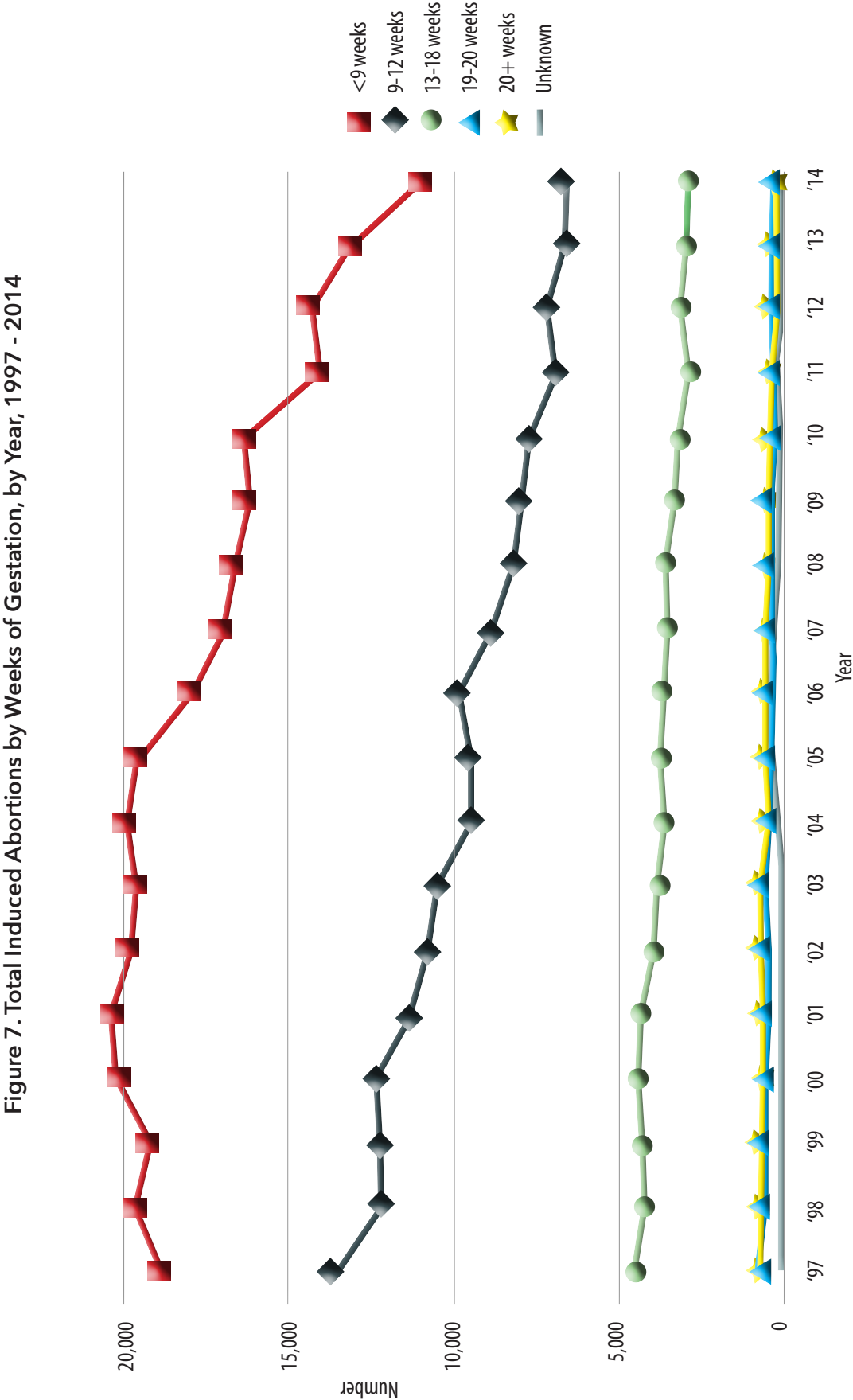


Figure 7. Total Induced Abortions by Weeks of Gestation, by Year, 1997 - 2014

More than half of all induced abortions involved pregnancies of less than nine weeks (52 percent), with approximately 31 percent involving pregnancies of nine to 12 weeks (Table 2). The proportion involving abortions of less than nine weeks increased from 49 percent in 1997, while the proportion between nine and 12 weeks declined from 35 percent to 31 percent (Figure 7, page 8). There were 510 abortions in 2014 involving pregnancies of 19 or more completed weeks of gestation (Table 2, page 10). That represents a decrease from the 532 reported in 2013. The abortion reporting form requests method used to determine gestational age: ultrasound was used in 99 percent of cases (Table 8b, page 24). The vast majority of reported abortions were obtained in six major metropolitan areas of Ohio.

Curettage was the most used method of termination in 2014 (83 percent) (Table 7, page 23). That method has decreased since 2001, when 87 percent of terminations were by curettage. Mifepristone was reported as the medication for non-surgical termination for 791 abortions, followed by 421 terminations using misoprostol, and 242 terminations using methotrexate (Table 7, page 23).

Figure 1. Resident Induced Abortions, Ohio, 1976 - 2014

Figure 3. Induced Abortions Reported in Ohio, by County of Occurrence, 2014

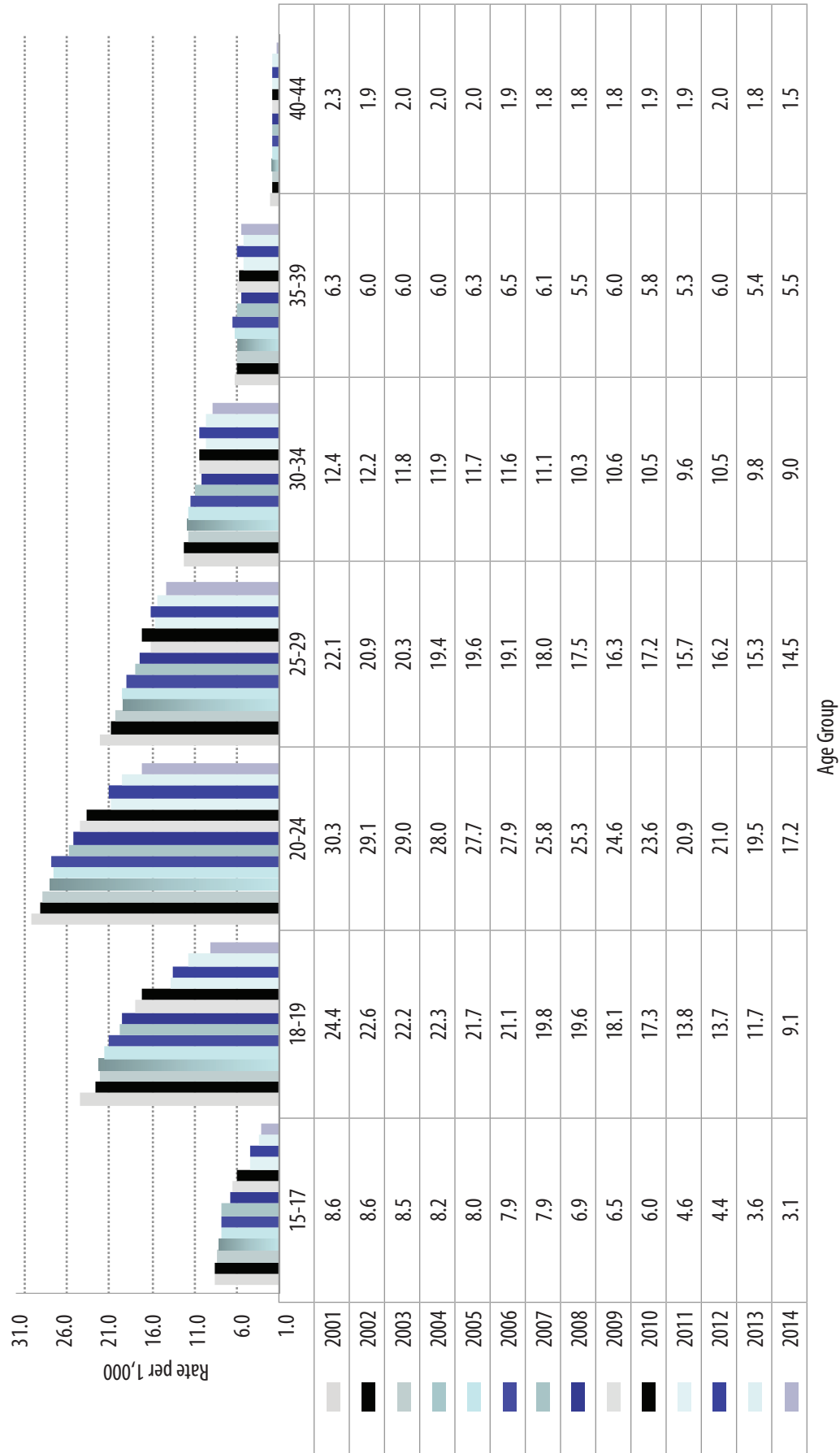


Abortion ratio is number of abortions per 1,000 live births.

Figure 6. Induced Abortion Ratio, by Age Group, Ohio Residents, 2002 - 2014
