Cribs for Kids® Programs

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH), Bureau of Maternal, Child and Family Health is partnering with Cribs for Kids® and local organizations throughout Ohio to provide Cribettes® or Pack 'n Plays and safe sleep education to eligible families while quantities last. Cribettes® and Pack 'n Plays are certified as being compliant with Consumer Product Safety Commission standards and are part of a safe sleep kit that also includes a fitted sheet and safe sleep educational materials. In order to receive a kit, eligible families must also receive education provided by their local program. In this session, the parent/caregiver(s) receives important education on infant safe sleep practices and how to properly use the Cribette® or Pack 'n Play for their baby.
