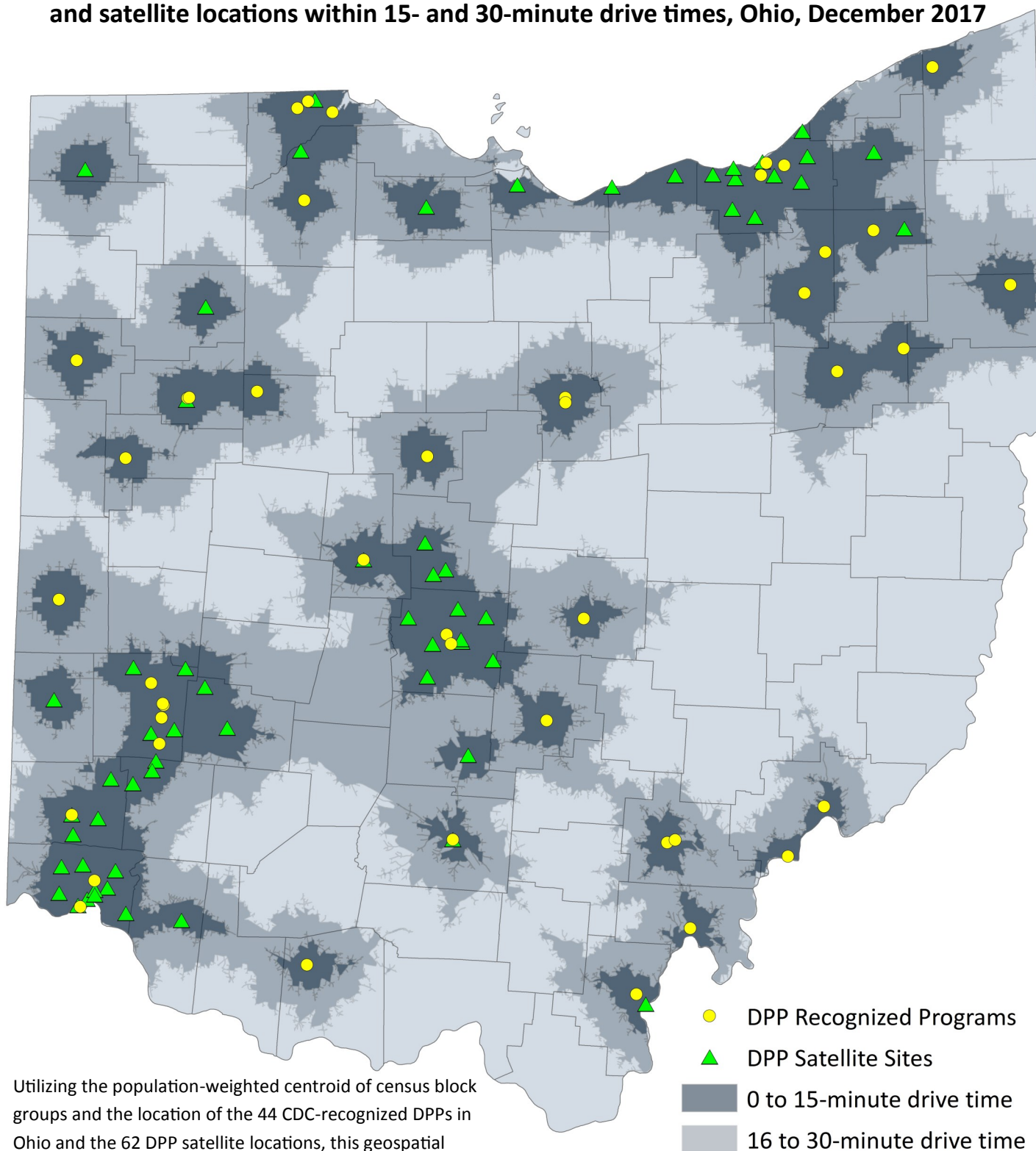


Population coverage of CDC-recognized Diabetes Prevention Programs (DPP) and satellite locations within 15- and 30-minute drive times, Ohio, December 2017



Utilizing the population-weighted centroid of census block groups and the location of the 44 CDC-recognized DPPs in Ohio and the 62 DPP satellite locations, this geospatial analysis shows that 65.4 percent of Ohioans live within a 15-minute drive of an Ohio DPP location. An additional 21.0 percent live within a 16 to 30-minute drive. The current infrastructure of DPP providers covers 86.4 percent of Ohioans, leaving more than 1.5 million people without ready access to these services.
